B.Cur. (E et A) – Temporarily Suspended

Thematically, this degree is sub-divided into Nursing Education and Management. The purpose of qualification is:

- To provide health care services with nurse managers who are instrumental in managing both human and material health care resources (Nationally and internationally).
- To provide health care services with nurse educators who are instrumental in producing nurses who are clinically competent to care for the healthy or ill individuals in terms of basic needs throughout the lifespan (Nationally and internationally).

The B.Cur (E et A) is a post-basic degree - it can only be done by a student who is registered as a General Nurse. A post-basic (a registered general nurse) has already completed 256 credits (32 modules). The B.Cur (E et A) degree is divided into two levels with the following exit levels – the first (diploma) level and the second (degree) level. Recognition of prior learning – for the second level – is based on criterion reference for:

- Diploma in Nursing Education, and
- Diploma in Nursing Management

B.Cur. (E et A) Option 1 (qualification code SNDEG1) – Temporarily Suspended

This is a 3 year qualification consisting of 60 modules.
